MOTION FOR DISCLOSURE

NOW COMES THE GOVERNMENT, through its undersigned attorney, and moves this Court to allow disclosure by Beattie Ashmore, receiver, of the Order entered in this case September 5, 2007, and annotated on the docket as Entry 43. The Order allows the receiver to take certain actions to secure assets identified as pertaining to this investigation. For the receiver to fulfill his duties, he must disclose the contents and authority contained within the Order to certain third parties who also have an interest in those assets. The Government believes that the receiver will be unable to fulfill his duties if he is not allowed to disclose the existence of the Order to these interested parties.

Therefore, the Government requests that this Court issue a Disclosure Order allowing the receiver to disclose the contents of the aforementioned order to those parties necessary for him to discharge his duties, with the further understanding that it not be disclosed by him beyond this group, and that the parties to whom the receiver discloses this Order be provided

with a copy of the Court's instructions not to disclose the information further.
