This matter comes before the court on a motion by the Government to allow disclosure by receiver Beattie B. Ashmore, Esquire of the contents of a sealed Order entered September 5, 2007, to third parties with an interest in the assets pertinent to the above-referenced matter. The Government asserts that the contents of the September 5, 2007 Order must be disclosed to certain third parties so that the receiver can discharge his duties. The Government's motion is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the contents of the September 5, 2007 Order may be disclosed to those third parties with whom the receiver must interact in order to fulfill his duties, and that the contents shall otherwise remain sealed. The receiver is authorized to convey a copy of the September 5, 2007 Order to third parties for their review in order to verify the authority granted to the receiver. The third parties who are allowed to view the September 5, 2007 Order are instructed that the information contained within the said Order is disclosed for the limited, express purpose of facilitating the receiver's efforts and should not be disseminated otherwise or the contents disclosed to any other persons or entities. A copy of this order shall be provided to every third party with whom the September 5, 2007 Order is discussed or conveyed.
